

JORDAN- ISRAEL – PALESTINE- EGYPT (12 Nights/13 Days)




*Visit the places where Jesus
Was Born, Preached, performed Miracles, was Crucified and Resurrected.
A pilgrimage through 4 Countries*

Day 1 (13 Nov): Departure from Canada.



Day 2 (14Nov) – Amman: Arrive at Queen Alia International Airport. Amman, Jordan. “Ahlan Wa Sahlan”– Welcome to Amman, Capital of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan, meet and assist through all formalities, transfer to hotel. Overnight stay is at Amman.



Day 3 (15 Nov) – Amman- Mount Nebo-Petra:

After breakfast proceed to Madaba (the city of Mosaics) Greek Orthodox Church of St. George, Mount Nebo, ten minutes west of Madaba, the final station in the life of prophet Moses, the Jordan Valley and the hills of Jerusalem Moses viewed the Promised Land that he would never enter. After the visit proceed to Petra for full day

sightseeing. Visit to the ancient Nabatean capital starts on horseback, followed by a walk through the Siq, a long narrow fissure between two overhanging cliffs. The tour then proceeds gradually to the unfold mysteries of the Rose-red City with its spectacular treasury, Royal Tombs, burial chambers and high places of sacrifice. Overnight stay is at Amman (B, L, D)



Day 4 (16 Nov): Nazareth, Cana, Mount

Tabor:. Then drive to the Holy Land welcomed by our guide at the border. Proceed to Nazareth Church of the Annunciation, Mary's House, and St. Joseph's Workshop. Visit to Cana, where we renew our marriage vows at the place where Jesus performed His first miracle of changing water into wine. Enroute to

Tiberius view Mt Tabor. Overnight stay is at Tiberius/ Netanya. (B, L, D)



Day 5 (17 Nov) - Mount of Beatitude, Capernaum, Sea of Galilee, Jaffa:

After breakfast visit Mount of Beatitude where Jesus preached the Sermon on the Mount, continue to Capernaum where we visit Jesus synagogue and the House of St. Peter. Proceed to the Primacy of Peter, where Jesus appeared to his disciples after the Resurrection and where he performed the

miraculous catch of the 153 fish and conferred Church authority upon Peter, continue on to Tabgha, the traditional site of the multiplication of loaves and fish followed by a boat ride on the Sea of Galilee. We travel to Yardenite – Jordan River, where we renew our baptismal vows right at the Jordan River. We will be driving through Acre and Caesarea. Drive along the coastal road to visit the old city of Jaffa

and see the Church dedicated to St. Peter commemorating his miraculous healing of Tabita. Overnight stay in Tiberius/ Netanya. (B, L, D)



Day 6 (18 Nov) - Mount of Olives and Gethsemane, Einkarem, Bethlehem:

After breakfast Visit Mount of Olives and visit the Church of ascension, the church of Pater Noster, descend to Dominus Flevit where Jesus wept over Jerusalem, proceed to the Garden of Gethsemane, Basilica of the Agony and tomb of St. Mary, the traditional House of Caipas where

Peter denied Jesus thrice and where Jesus was kept in the dungeon proceed to Einkarem, visit church of John Bahai, Bethlehem the Shepherd's field and the Church of Nativity, the Birth Place of the Lord Jesus, Visit St. Jerome's Grotto where the Bible was translated from Hebrew. Visit St. Mark Convent the traditional site where Mary went to sleep after Cruzification, Last Supper Room, where we remember Last Supper and the descent of the Holy Spirit upon the Apostles on Pentecost. There after walk to the Dormition Abby and the traditional site of the Tomb of King David (visit other Upper room). We end the day with visit to the Western Wailing Wall. Overnight in Palestine. (B, L, D)



Day 7 (19 Nov) - Old City- Golgotha, Bethany, Jericho, Dead Sea:

After breakfast, proceed to Jerusalem, we enter the Old City through Herod's or Lion's Gate. Continue on foot to the church of Condemnation and Flagellation, where we begin the Via Dolorosa. The last five Stations of the Cross are situated inside the Holy

Sepulcher. The present route and follow the footsteps of our Lord Jesus on his way to Calvary, culminating the journey to Golgotha and the place of the tomb itself the Church of the Holy Sepulchre. Then proceed to Bethany the house of Martha, Mary and Lazarus (Lazarus Tomb), Jericho, see Mount of Temptation and Sycamore Tree, Dead Sea. Overnight stay is at Palestine (B, L, D)



Day 8 (20 Nov) - Yaad Vashem, Knesset, Tel

Aviv city: After breakfast Proceed to YAAD VASHEM (the holocaust museum), the place the Jewish nation pays tribute to millions Jewish people who died across the world The memorial consists of a 44.5-acre complex containing the

Holocaust History Museum, memorial sites such as the Children’s Memorial and the Hall of Remembrance. A core goal of Yad Vashem’s founders was to recognize gentiles who, at personal risk and without a financial or evangelistic motive, chose to save their Jewish brethren from the ongoing genocide during the Holocaust. Those recognized by Israel as Righteous among the Nations are honored in a section of Yad Vashem known as the Garden of the Righteous among the Nations. Later we proceed to Knesset, the Israeli parliament. It is an impressive modern building with state of the art facilities. Afternoon we proceed for Half day visit of the Tel Aviv, the capital city of Israel. Tel Aviv is also known as the White City and is a reflection of the new state of Israel itself and as such, it underwent virtually all the marvelous chain of events that occurred in this Middle Eastern small piece of land over the last 120 years. You will be visiting- Neve tzedek (Oasis of Justice) is actually the first neighborhood of Tel Aviv, Beit Hasofrim’ (house of writers), Bialik House, the house of Haim Nehman Bialik – National Poet of Israel, Tel Aviv Port and Jaffa area. Overnight stay is at Palestine. (B, L, D)



Day 9 (21 Nov) – Qumran, Red Sea, Taba: After breakfast Proceed to Taba via Sodom, Gomorrah and Eliat, Cross Taba boarder and transfer to Hotel. Overnight stay is in Taba. (B, L, D)

Day 10 (22 Nov) – St Catherine Monastery, Mount Sinai, Sharm El Shaikh: After breakfast proceed to St

Catherine Monastery, where one gets an opportunity to see the Burning bush and view of the Mount Sinai. Then drive to Sharm el Shaikh a city on the southern tip of the Sinai Peninsula, in South Sinai Governorate, Egypt, on the coastal strip along the Red Sea. Visit the Heavenly Coptic church. Overnight stay is at Sharm El Shaikh. (B, L, D)



Day 11 (23 Nov) – Sharm El Shaikh – Cairo: After breakfast transfer to Cairo. On arrival at Cairo proceed to hotel. Check in and overnight stay is at Cairo. (B, L, D).

Day 12 (24 Nov)– Sphinx, Pyramids, Nile Cruise: After breakfast visit The



Hanging Church is the most famous Coptic Christian church in Cairo, as well as possibly the first built in Basilican style. The Church is named for its location above a gatehouse of Babylon Fortress, the Roman fortress in Coptic Cairo); its nave is suspended over a passage. The church is approached by twenty-nine steps, Holy family church where the Holy family were

in Exile for 03 years and hid to escape the wrath, then visit, the Pyramids, Sphinx and Later visit the Egyptian museum. Late night transfer to Airport. (B, L, D)

Day 13 (25 Nov) – Cairo: Early morning departure to Canada. Arrive Canada in the evening.

Facility to Daily Holy Mass
